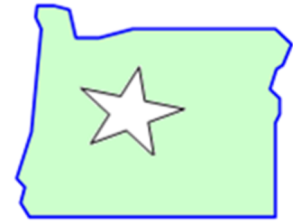

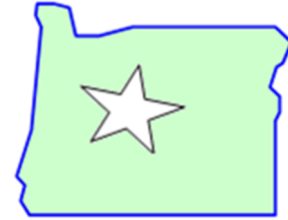

All,

As some of you may be aware we have been working to expand involvement in the local Central Oregon ICC Chapter. Mainly, the Chapter Officers and current members have been coming together to brainstorm ideas to attract more people to our monthly gatherings. In the past it has been mentioned that our Chapter meetings lacked content of interest and, expectedly, people are just busy and can't make the meetings.

In an effort to revitalize the monthly Chapter meetings we felt it would be best to reach out to all staff in each jurisdiction to see what content they would like to see discussed or presented at each meeting. We are currently in the process of scheduling a guest speaker every other month to discuss a specific code-related topic or to present on a product of interest at our Chapter meetings. In the alternating months we would like to set aside time for the majority of the meeting to have an open "code forum" to discuss anything of concern we are seeing in the field or anything we would like to be more consistent on across the jurisdictions.

Your department heads have forwarded your e-mail addresses to me so that I could reach out and be a point of contact in asking "What would most interest you as far as topics of discussion and guest speakers?" "What would you like to get from the Chapter meetings if you were to attend?" "What would entice you to attend if you don't already?"

We are looking to compile the responses received to see what people want and create a calendar of speakers and topics to send out far enough in advance that individuals may be better situated to attend the Chapter's monthly meetings and gain something from attending. Some topics of interest that have come up more recently that our current chapter members would like to learn more about are: firestopping, NFPA 72, ASHRAE 90.1, multi-family construction, code update/changes to the 2019 OSSC, etc. What we would like is to get your input on anything of interest to you.

Any responses are much appreciated and will be placed in the overall tally of topics we will work to get speakers or open code forum discussions started on. Our local Chapter is an ICC preferred provider, meaning you can earn CEU's toward any ICC certifications through Chapter meeting attendance as well as any education institutes that are put on throughout the year (less traveling to the valley to get these). Attached is an example of one of the presenters/speakers we have used in the past at the local education institute and the course topics available.
